

Rehab Director's Forum Resource Dietician Survey:

What dietary services to you have? Do you have a Feeding Clinic?

A

We have a dietician for our clinic 2 days a week. We are not able to bill for her services but would like to capture charges. Since this is a nonrevenue producing position we are not able to hire her for more hours and thus are having difficulty finding a trained person who is willing to work part time. We have a monthly Feeding Clinic with a medical director, an OT, SLP, Dietician, and RN.

B

A nutritionist has scheduled hours at our outpatient facility to respond to feeding and other issues. We don't have a feeding clinic; speech therapists provide individual outpatient evaluation and treatment, with participation of OTs and nutrition as needed.

C

Clinical Nutrition is independent, that means stand alone, not part of Food Service. It is a clinical service that partners with the medical team. We do have a multidisciplinary Feeding Team that includes nutrition services, OT, and Speech and Language Pathology. We also have a per-diem psychologist.

D

What dietary services to you have? We have dieticians who cover all inpatient units, outpatient services and several interdisciplinary clinics

We are currently in the pilot phase of our Feeding Clinic. We run it with a multi-disciplinary group including GI MD, support from GI Nursing, Dietician, OT, SLP, and Psychology.

What dietary services to you have? 0.2 FTE Registered Dietician; + collaboration w/ community RD's-a few physician offices have their own
Do you have a Feeding Clinic? No

We do not have a feeding clinic but would love to start one. We do have a dietician on the IP side for the rehab unit who works in the hospital but not in the OP setting.

Have 2 full-time registered dieticians that primarily serve IP population. We can request them for an OP consult. No Feeding Clinic, but have a multidisc clinic in which we will see kids with feeding issues and develop a treatment plan (OP, Day Treatment) We have a contact for our physiatrists who also schedules all multidisc evals/appts with referrals coming in by phone. For clinical questions or brainstorming on feeding we pull our ST and/or OT supervisors in
